Force Report: Quarter 2 2018/19

The data supplied has been taken from information held on the Criminal History System (CHS) and is accurate as of November 15, 2018.

Recorded Police Warnings (RPW) and Anti-Social Behaviour Fixed Penalty Notices (ASB FPN) are just two of a range of disposal options available to the Police in relation to lower level offending. These schemes are intended to have a positive impact on individuals by providing an intervention mechanism that is timely, justifiable and proportionate to the crime or incident under review.

An RPW or ASB FPN can be issued for a range of offences with the main offences detailed in this report, offenders can and will continue to be reported to the Crown Office and Procurator Fiscal Service where appropriate. An RPW or ASB FPN is not a conviction but may be considered relevant information for the purposes of a Protection of Vulnerable Groups (PVG) disclosure certificate and an enhanced disclosure certificate.

These figures do not include direct measures issued in respect of Road Traffic Offences.

Please note that Police Direct Measures are not available at local council level as this geographical data is not collected as part of the CHS data.

These data are being published as experimental statistics, and are Police Scotland management information. They are not official statistics.
