Multi Member Ward Plan Update 2014

Our focus. Your priorities.

This policing plan will outline the priorities your community identified during our most recent consultation and will inform you of how we plan to address them throughout the year.

Our focus is to reduce crime and disorder, to increase public reassurance within our community and to keep people safe.

We will continue to work closely with our partners and find effective long-term solutions to the issues you raised.

Local Priorities

This update sets out how we intend to deal with your priorities. You identified that the priorities for the Clackmannanshire East area were:

1. Drugs

You told us your concerns about drug dealing and drug abuse.

2. Antisocial Behaviour

You highlighted issues regarding youths causing annoyance associated with rowdy drunken behaviour.

3. Road Safety

You told us about speeding motorists and persons parking dangerously who pose a danger on your roads.

4. Housebreaking

You expressed concern about your home being broken into and the impact upon you and your family.

We have acted on your concerns and are sure you will have seen improvements in the Clackmannanshire East area.

Our actions carried out to date.

Drugs

We have executed search warrants and made arrests relating to drug dealing following information from the community. We have completed searches of persons suspected to be in possession of controlled drugs.

Antisocial Behaviour

We have completed joint patrols with community wardens in Clackmannanshire East to tackle antisocial behaviour. We have deployed additional officers in Clackmannanshire East to keep our streets safe. We have visited problem addresses with partners to ensure that disruptive behaviour is altered.

Road Safety

We have made our roads safer by targeting speeding motorists and enforcing seat belt and mobile phone legislation. We have completed operations with our partners to ensure vehicles are roadworthy.

Housebreaking

We have disrupted the activities of offenders by carrying out additional patrols within identified areas.

We support local crime reduction initiatives by working with partners and local businesses.

In addition to this, you can expect to see a number of other things happening in the next few weeks and months:

Drugs

We will seek help from the community by asking you to provide information about drug dealing. We will continue to target individuals involved in drugs supply in Clackmannan, Forestmill, Dollar and Muckhart.

Antisocial Behaviour

We will continue to patrol identified areas to reduce antisocial behaviour. We will target those who supply alcohol to young people. We will work with partners to target those who persistently behave in an antisocial manner.

Road Safety

We will continue to make our roads safer with speed enforcement campaigns. We will work with Clackmannanshire Council to ensure the road network is as safe as possible.

Housebreaking

We will continue to support local crime initiatives by working with partners and local businesses. We will continue to target offenders and carry out patrols within identified areas to disrupt crime.
