

## Our focus. Your priorities.

This policing plan update will outline the priorities your community identified during our most recent consultation and will inform you of how we plan to address them throughout the year.

Our focus is to reduce crime and disorder, to increase public reassurance within our community and to keep people safe.

We will continue to work closely with our partners and find effective long-term solutions to the issues you raised.

### Local Priorities

This plan sets out how we intend to deal with your priorities. You identified that the priorities for the East Kilbride Central North area were:

#### **1. Assault & Violent Crime**

You told us your concerns regarding violent crime, recognising the connection with other forms of antisocial behaviour.

#### **2. Drunk or Disorderly Behaviour**

You told us your concerns about public drinking, youth disorder, vandalism and graffiti.

#### **3. Drug Dealing & Drug Misuse**

You told us you were worried about the impact of drugs and drug related behaviour in your area.

#### **4. Housebreaking & Other Thefts**

You told us you were concerned regarding break-ins and other thefts, particularly around the home.

We have acted on your concerns and are sure you will have seen improvements in the East Kilbride Central North area.

# Our actions carried out to date.

## **Violence, Disorder & Antisocial Behaviour**

Through focused high-visibility patrols and in partnership with the Problem Solving Group, we have targeted problematic individuals/locations, carried out effective interventions and reduced violence, disorder and antisocial behaviour.

## **Drug Dealing & Drug Misuse**

Acting on intelligence provided by you, focussed activity against individuals and premises concerned in drug dealing/misuse has met with great success.

## **Preventing Housebreaking & Thefts**

We have acted on community intelligence, carried out preventative/enforcement action and detected offenders.

## **Road Crime**

Focussing on reducing road casualties, we have targeted repeat offenders and those who blatantly commit offences.

**In addition to this, you can expect to see a number of other things happening in the next few weeks and months:**

## **Antisocial Behaviour**

We will continue to provide a high-visibility presence in your community to prevent and reduce the likelihood of crime occurring. We will target those individuals who cause the most harm.

## **Partnership Working**

In partnership with East Kilbride Problem Solving Group, we will carry out effective interventions against individuals and problematic locations reducing violence, disorder and antisocial behaviour.

## **Preventing Housebreaking & Thefts**

We will act on community intelligence, focusing on preventative and enforcement activity to deter/detect housebreakers and thieves.

## **Road Crime**

We will focus on keeping you safe on the road through enforcement activity.
