# Our focus. Your priorities.

This policing plan will outline the priorities your community identified during our most recent consultation. It will inform you of the action we have taken up till now to address those priorities throughout the coming year.

Our focus is to reduce crime and disorder, to increase public reassurance within your community and to keep people safe.

We will continue to work closely with our partners and find effective long-term solutions to the issues you raised.

## **Local Priorities**

You identified that the policing priorities for East Kilbride Central North area are as follows:

### **1. Drunk or Disorderly Behaviour**

You told us your concerns about public drinking, youth disorder, vandalism and graffiti.

### **2. Assault and Violent Crime**

You told us your concerns regarding violent crime, recognising the connection with other forms of antisocial behaviour.

### **3. Drug Use and Drug Dealing**

You told us you were worried about the impact of drugs and drug related behaviour in your area.

### **4. Housebreakings & Other Thefts**

You told us you were concerned regarding break-ins and other thefts, particularly around the home.

We have listened to your concerns and comments from the East Kilbride Central North area.

# Our actions to date.

## **1. Drunk or Disorderly Behaviour**

We will continue to provide a high-visibility presence in your community to prevent and reduce the likelihood of crime occurring. We will target those individuals who cause the most harm.

## **2. Assault and Violent Crime**

Through focused high-visibility patrols and in partnership with the Problem Solving Group, we have targeted problematic individuals/locations, carried out effective interventions and reduced violence, disorder and antisocial behaviour.

## **3. Drug Dealing & Drug Misuse**

Acting on intelligence provided by you, focussed activity against individuals and premises concerned in drug dealing/misuse has met with great success.

## **4. Housebreaking & Other Thefts**

We have acted on community intelligence, carried out preventative/enforcement action and detected offenders.



# In the coming months.

## **1. Drunk or Disorderly Behaviour**

These are the issues that you want to see addressed. In addition to direct enforcement action, advice and signposting to supporting partners will also be given. We will deploy resources to the areas that cause you the greatest concern.

## **2. Assault and Violent Crime**

We will reduce the potential of crime occurring in your community by providing a high visibility presence. We will focus our proactive stop and search powers towards the individuals who engage in violent acts or carry weapons.

## **3. Drug Dealing and Drug Misuse**

We will continue to use the intelligence you provide to target drug dealing and drug misuse.

## **4. Housebreaking & Other Thefts**

These are the issues that you want to see addressed. In addition to direct enforcement action, advice and signposting to supporting partners will also be given. We will act on community intelligence, focusing on preventative and enforcement activity to deter/detect housebreakers and thieves.
