Our focus. Your priorities.

This policing plan will outline the priorities your community identified during our most recent consultation. It will inform you of the action we have taken up till now to address those priorities and how we plan to continue to address them throughout the year.

Our focus is to reduce crime and disorder, to increase public reassurance within your community and to keep people safe.

We will continue to work closely with our partners and find effective long-term solutions to the issues you raised.

Local Priorities

You identified that the policing priorities for Clydebank Central are as follows:

1. Violent Crime.

You told us that violent crime was a concern within your community.

2. Drug dealing and Drug Misuse.

You told us that drug misuse and drug dealing was of concern.

3. Vandalism and Graffiti.

You told us of your concerns surrounding vandalism and graffiti in your community.

4. Rowdy Drunken Behaviour in Public Places.

You told us that rowdy drunken behaviour was impacting on your community.

We have listened to your concerns and are working hard to make improvements in the Clydebank Central area.

Our actions to date.

Violent Crime

The Community Investigation Unit has been proactively targeting those individuals involved in violent crime in your area. Your local officers have been carrying out interventions with these individuals to detect and deter acts of violence.

Drug Dealing and Misuse

Your Community Investigation Unit continues to develop intelligence on people who deal in and use controlled drugs. Local crime units have targeted those responsible and executed warrants at locations where drug dealing is taking place. Where offences are detected we share information with housing providers to support action on tenancy agreements.

Vandalism and Graffiti

We have increased high visibility patrols in areas affected by vandalism and graffiti. Our officers work in partnership with West Dunbartonshire Council to target those involved in the defacement of your community.

Rowdy Drunken Behaviour in Public Places

Local officers have been deployed in the areas where intelligence and crime trends show there is an issue with such behaviour. This proactive deployment of resources is to combat anti-social behaviour. Officers use all available legislation to deal with perpetrators and work closely with licensed premises to prevent such behaviour.

In the coming months.

Violent Crime

We will continue to carry out dedicated patrols in your area targeting those individuals who are involved in violent crime. Our focus will be on dealing with the right people and the right place and time to reduce levels of violence in the community. Where offenders are detected we will work with our partners in Criminal Justice to seek appropriate restrictions on persistent offenders.

Drug Dealing and Misuse

We will continue to gather information from the community in relation to drug dealing and misuse. We will take robust action against those identified as being involved in this type of criminality. To assist us we would encourage you to contact us on 101 or through Crimestoppers on 0800 555111 with any information you have relating to drug dealing activities.

Vandalism and Graffiti

We will continue to work with the local authority to identify persons vandalising the Clydebank Central area. Where repeat locations are identified we will increase patrols to detect and deter this type of criminality.

Rowdy Drunken Behaviour in Public Places

We will continue to use analytical reports and intelligence to identify locations where disorder is occurring and will target these areas to prevent this type of behaviour. Community Officers will perform high visibility foot and cycle patrols to detect those individuals who are having a negative impact on the community. We will continue to promote diversionary activities for youths to prevent them engaging in disorder.
