Community Policing Plan Update 2015

Our focus. Your priorities.

This policing plan update will cover the priorities your community identified during our most recent consultation, outline what we have done over the past six months to address them and inform you of how we plan to continue addressing them throughout the year.

Our focus is to reduce crime and disorder, to increase public reassurance within our community and to keep people safe.

We will continue to work closely with our partners and find effective long-term solutions to the issues you raised.

Local Priorities

This update sets out how we intend to deal with your priorities. You identified that the priorities for the Girvan and South Carrick area were:

1. Dishonesty

You told us of your concerns about domestic housebreakings and other forms of theft.

2. Road Safety

You told us speeding motorists and other forms of dangerous or antisocial driving were causing you concern.

3. Violent Crime

You told us that you had concerns about violent crime in your area.

4. Drug Dealing and Drug Misuse

You told us that drug dealing and drug misuse were of concern.

We have acted on your concerns and are sure you will have seen improvements in the Girvan and South Carrick area.

Our actions carried out to date.

Dishonesty

We have proactively targeted individuals involved in housebreaking and thefts ensuring forensic opportunities are captured. We patrol at key times and locations to deter and detect such crimes. We have offered crime prevention and security advice to improve security.

Road Safety

Community police officers and Road Policing colleagues have patrolled in prominent locations and carried out periodic road checks to enforce speed limits and positively influence driver behaviour.

Violent Crime

We patrol locally identified 'hot spots' in relation to violence and antisocial behaviour. We target known violent and domestic abuse offenders to deter re-offending. We proactively monitor bail conditions and report bail offences to the Procurator Fiscal Service.

Drug Dealing and Drug Misuse

We used intelligence provided by the community to proactively deter, detect and arrest those involved in the supply of controlled drugs. We have shared this information with South Ayrshire Council to support tenancy action.

In addition to this, you can expect to see a number of other things happening in the next few weeks and months:

Dishonesty

We will continue to use intelligence and forensics to identify, target and arrest individuals suspected to be involved in housebreaking. We will patrol relevant areas to prevent, deter and detect crimes of dishonesty.

Road Safety

We will continue to deploy officers with speed detection equipment to areas of concern highlighted by communities in order to reduce road traffic collisions and injuries.

Violent Crime

We will continue to proactively target those who engage in violence, domestic violence and anti-social behaviour and utilise high profile patrols where and when required.

Drug Dealing and Drug Misuse

We will continue to target those concerned in the production, sale or supply of controlled drugs. We will report those found in possession of controlled drugs to the Procurator Fiscal and work with partners on both education and enforcement.
