Our focus. Your priorities.

This policing plan will outline the priorities your community identified during our most recent consultation. It will inform you of the action we have taken up until now to address those priorities and how we plan to continue to address them throughout the year.

Our focus is to reduce crime and disorder, to increase public reassurance within your community and to keep people safe.

We will continue to work closely with our partners and find effective long-term solutions to the issues you raised.

Local Priorities

You identified that the policing priorities for Perth City South area were:

1. Road Safety

You told us the area that concerned you most was speeding vehicles and inconsiderate parking around schools.

2. Bogus Workmen

You told us your concerns about the elderly and vulnerable being targeted by bogus workmen.

3. Domestic Abuse

You told us your concerns about people living with an abusive partner.

We have acted on your concerns and are sure you will have seen improvements in Perth City South area.



Our actions to date.

Road Safety

We have looked to increase the number of Road Checks in your area and engage positively with young people through education while working alongside our various partners.

Bogus Workmen

We have continued to work alongside community wardens to identify and support vulnerable persons by identifying areas of concern and focussed patrols in these areas using intelligence to target offenders.

Domestic Abuse

We continue to visit victims of domestic crimes to ensure that they are safe. Domestic perpetrators will be checked on a regular basis to ensure that they do not re-offend in any way.



In the coming months.

Road Safety

Our Community Coordinators will be engaging with local schools to promote Road Safety Education, feedback will be sought and the areas you identified will be targeted.

Bogus Workmen

Officers will continue to look out for those offending and working along side or partners like Trading Standards we will act robustly against the offenders identified.

Domestic Violence

We continue to visit victims of domestic crimes. Domestic perpetrators will continue to be checked on a regular basis to ensure that they do not re-offend in any way.
