FREEDOM OF INFORMATION (SCOTLAND) ACT 2002

I refer to your recent request for information which has been handled in accordance with the Freedom of Information (Scotland) Act 2002.

For ease of reference, your request is replicated below together with the response.

Thank you for your response regarding my FOI request of "[Alcohol-related arrests details from Murrayfield rugby matches 2010/11-2020/21](#)". If you could send over the dates, crime code descriptions and number of offences/arrests for all group 6 offences that start with the references 600... and 610... and the group 7 offences that start 301... in the WM19 beat area of Edinburgh from 2010/11 to 2020/21

I must first of all advise you that we have interpreted your request to be for crime statistics for those crime codes which relate specifically to alcohol.

In response to your request, please see the tables at the end of this document.

All statistics are provisional and should be treated as management information. All data have been extracted from Police Scotland internal systems and are correct as at 12th December 2022.

The Recorded and Detected Crimes are extracted using the Date Raised, and then selecting the following Stats Class Codes: '606001', '606003', '606004', '606005', '606006', '606007', '606008', '606101', '606102', '606103', '606104', '606105', '606106', '606107', '606108', '606109', '606110', '606199', '730101', '730102', '730103', '730104', '730105', '730106', '730107', '730108'

If you are dissatisfied with the way in which Police Scotland has dealt with your request, you are entitled, in the first instance, to request a review of our actions and decisions. Your request must specify the matter which gives rise to your dissatisfaction and it must be submitted within 40 working days of receiving this response - either by email to foi@scotland.police.uk or by post to Information Management (Disclosure), Police Scotland, Clyde Gateway, 2 French Street, Dalarnock, G40 4EH.

If you remain dissatisfied following the outcome of that review, you are thereafter entitled to apply to the Office of the Scottish Information Commissioner within six months for a decision.
