Freedom of Information Request - Response

I refer to your recent correspondence seeking access to your own personal data.

Your request is technically a **Subject Access Request (SAR)** and it will therefore be considered in terms of the Data Protection Act 2018/ GDPR as explained on our website.

Our Data Protection team will contact you separately in relation to your SAR.

Because you addressed your request to FOI, we are required by law to provide this additional response in terms of the Freedom of Information (Scotland) Act 2002 specifically.

In terms of section 18 of that Act, I am therefore refusing to confirm or deny whether Police Scotland holds information about you. The public interest overwhelmingly lies in protecting your right to privacy and an individual's own personal information is exempt from disclosure in terms of the exemption at section 38(1)(a).

I understand that the statement above may seem confusing and/ or unhelpful in the circumstances but I would stress once again that this is the response to your FOI request only - a SAR will be progressed separately.

I can further advise you that with regard to information in respect of your husband, sections 38(1)(b) and 38(1)(2A) of the Act apply insofar as you have requested third party personal data which is exempt from disclosure where it is assessed that disclosure would contravene the data protection principles as defined in the Act.
