FREEDOM OF INFORMATION (SCOTLAND) ACT 2002

I refer to your recent request for information which has been handled in accordance with the Freedom of Information (Scotland) Act 2002.

For ease of reference, your request is replicated below together with the response.

To request all dates that Police Scotland attended Clark Contracts portocabins situated in Drummond Street in 2022 For grafitti vandalism For any other reason

In researching your request we have reviewed the address details of all reported incidents for the relevant period with a recorded locus of Drummond Street, Edinburgh generally or a specific address on Drummond Street.

I can confirm that none of the addresses contain any reference to Clark Contracts and/ or portakabins and in terms of section 17 of the Act, the information sought is therefore not held by Police Scotland.

It is of course possible that police officers attend at any location for reasons other than in response to a specific incident - for example general patrols and/ or carrying out enquiries in relation to an incident or crime at a different locus.

Such information is not in any way searchable, details only being recorded in officer notebooks and/ or in the records associated with the other incident.

If you are dissatisfied with the way in which Police Scotland has dealt with your request, you are entitled, in the first instance, to request a review of our actions and decisions.

Your request must specify the matter which gives rise to your dissatisfaction and it must be submitted within 40 working days of receiving this response - either by email to foi@scotland.police.uk or by post to Information Management (Disclosure), Police Scotland, Clyde Gateway, 2 French Street, Dalmarnock, G40 4EH.

If you remain dissatisfied following the outcome of that review, you are thereafter entitled to apply to the Office of the Scottish Information Commissioner within six months for a decision.
