## FREEDOM OF INFORMATION (SCOTLAND) ACT 2002

I refer to your recent request for information which has been handled in accordance with the Freedom of Information (Scotland) Act 2002.

For ease of reference, your request is replicated below together with the response.

### **Earl Street Scotstoun:**

**Please can you advise as to what the area is like with regards to criminal activity and vandalism etc**

In response to your request, please see the tables at the end of this letter. I can advise you that the information provided relates to circumstances where they have been reports made to the police (incidents) and/ or where criminality has occurred (crimes).

All statistics are provisional and should be treated as management information. All data have been extracted from Police Scotland internal systems and are correct as at 12th January 2022.

The Recorded Crimes are extracted using the Date Raised, Detected Crimes are extracted using the Date Detected. These are then mapped to Earl Street, Glasgow, using ArcGIS software (based on the Grid East and Grid North recorded). The period provided is 1st January 2017 - 31st December 2021 (Calendar Years)

Please note, that crimes relating to the Covid-19 are not included

Please note, not all crime reports have a Grid East and Grid North recorded. As such, they are not included within the records plotted and then selected.

If you are dissatisfied with the way in which Police Scotland has dealt with your request, you are entitled, in the first instance, to request a review of our actions and decisions.

Your request must specify the matter which gives rise to your dissatisfaction and it must be submitted within 40 working days of receiving this response - either by email to [foi@scotland.pnn.police.uk](mailto:foi@scotland.pnn.police.uk) or by post to Information Management (Disclosure), Police Scotland, Clyde Gateway, 2 French Street, Dalmarnock, G40 4EH.

If you remain dissatisfied following the outcome of that review, you are thereafter entitled to apply to the Office of the Scottish Information Commissioner within six months for a decision.
