FREEDOM OF INFORMATION (SCOTLAND) ACT 2002

I refer to your recent request for information which has been handled in accordance with the Freedom of Information (Scotland) Act 2002.

For ease of reference, your request is replicated below together with the response.

1. How many (a) police officers and (b) police staff who joined Police Scotland in each year since April 2013, left within (i) 1 year (ii) 2 years (iii) 3 years, (iv) 4 years and (v) 5 years, also broken down by (A) gender and (B) department.

Table 1, Table 2 and Table 3 at the end of this document provide the number of police officers and police staff who joined and left Police Scotland from 2014 to current date, broken down by length of service, gender and division.

Please note that due to Record Retention policy within Strategic Workforce, I am unable to provide you with a breakdown for the 2013/14 period.

As such, in terms of Section 17 of the Freedom of Information (Scotland) Act 2002, this represents a notice that the information you seek is not held by Police Scotland.

2. How many BAME (a) officers and (b) staff who joined Police Scotland in each year since April 2013, left within (i) 1 year, (ii) 2 years, (iii) 3 years, (iv) 4 years and (v) 5 years, and how does this compare to the retention rates for Police Scotland officers and staff as a whole.

Police officers and police staff provide their personal sensitive data on a voluntary basis. It is not mandatory for them to provide the information to Police Scotland.

The ethnic origin categories are categorised as follows:

- **BME** Mixed or Multiple Ethnic Group, Asian Pakistani, Asian Indian, Asian Bangladeshi, Asian Chinese, Asian Other, African, African Other, Caribbean, Black, Caribbean or Black Other, Arab and Other Ethnic Group.
- White Minority White Irish, White Gypsy/Traveller, White Polish and White Other.
- All Other White British White English, White Northern Irish, White Welsh and White Other British.
- Choose not to Disclose Individuals who do not wish to provide their personal sensitive data.

 Not Recorded – The data is unknown due to the member of staff not having an opportunity to complete the E&D Questionnaire on SCOPE.

Between 01/04/2013 and 07/12/2021, 702 police officers who joined Police Scotland left during the first five years of service. This equates to 11% of those who joined during the identified reporting period. 89% are still in service or left after six or more years' service.

8% of those who identified as White Scottish left during the first five years of service compared to 23% who identified as Other White British, 10% who identified as White Minority, 14% who identified as BME, 12% who identified as Choose not to Disclose and 23% whose data was not recorded.

For police officers who joined between 01/04/2013 and 07/12/2021 and left in the first five years, the most common lengths of service by each ethnic origin category are as follows:

- 1 years' service was the most common for those identifying as White Scottish or BME
- 2 years' service was the most common for those identifying as Other White British
- <1 year service was the most common for those identifying as White Minority or whose data was unknown and therefore not recorded.
- 3 years' service was the most common for those who identified as Choose not to Disclose

Between 01/04/2013 and 07/12/2021, 906 police staff who joined Police Scotland left during the first five years of service. This equates to 27% of those who joined during the identified reporting period. 73% are still in service or left after six or more years' service

It should be noted that police staff are employed on different terms and conditions than those for police officers. Police staff can be employed on temporary contracts for short periods of time. The roles carried out by police staff are varied and this may impact on the length of time and individual chooses to work for Police Scotland.

26% of those who identified as White Scottish left during the first five years of service compared to 29% who identified as Other White British, 29% who identified as White Minority, 35% who identified as BME, 41% who identified as Choose not to Disclose and 38% whose data was not recorded.

For police staff who joined between 01/04/2013 and 07/12/2021 and left in the first five years, the most common lengths of service by each ethnic origin category are as follows:

- <1 year was the most common for all ethnic origin categories with the exception of those identifying as White Minority where 1 year was the most common.
- 3. Of the (a) officers and (b) staff who have left employment with Police Scotland since April 2013, how many provided a cause or reason for their departure, broken down by (i) reason for departure and (ii) department, and has Police Scotland measured how many left due to (A) burnout or exhaustion (B) racial discrimination or harassment, or (C) gender discrimination or harassment.

Table 4 and Table 5 at the end of this document provide the number of police officers and police staff who left Police Scotland from 2014 to current date, broken down by leaving reason and division.

Please be advised however that Police Scotland does not record if someone is 'burnout' etc. The only possible way to determine the reason for an individual leaving would be to carry out case by case assessment of all personnel files.

As illustrated by the tables below, this would involve individually examining a vast number of files, and in some cases, the reason for leaving may not even be recorded.

As you may be aware the current cost threshold is £600 and I estimate that it would cost well in excess of this amount to process your request.

As such, and in terms of Section 16(4) of the Freedom of Information (Scotland) Act 2002 where Section 12(1) of the Act (Excessive Cost of Compliance) has been applied, this represents a refusal notice for the information sought.

If you are dissatisfied with the way in which Police Scotland has dealt with your request, you are entitled, in the first instance, to request a review of our actions and decisions.

Your request must specify the matter which gives rise to your dissatisfaction and it must be submitted within 40 working days of receiving this response - either by email to foi@scotland.pnn.police.uk or by post to Information Management (Disclosure), Police Scotland, Clyde Gateway, 2 French Street, Dalmarnock, G40 4EH.

If you remain dissatisfied following the outcome of that review, you are thereafter entitled to apply to the Office of the Scottish Information Commissioner within six months for a decision.

Should you wish to appeal against the Office of the Scottish Information Commissioner's decision, there is an appeal to the Court of Session on a point of law only.
