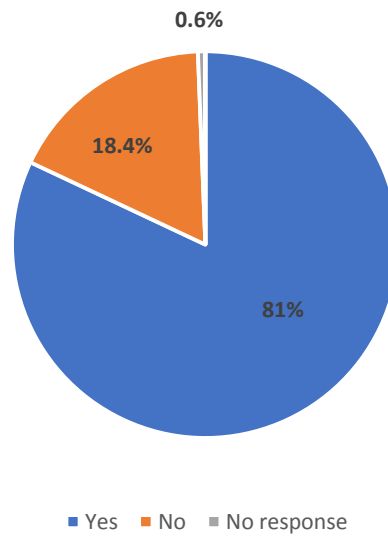
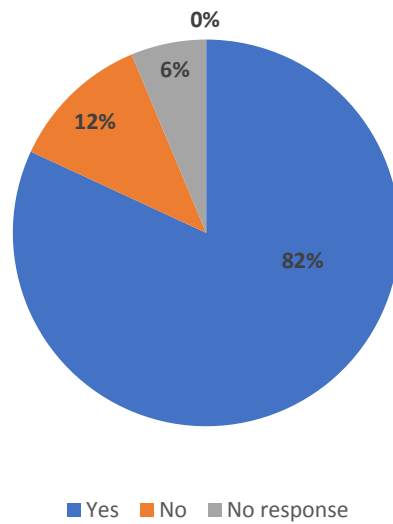

Q1 Do you agree with LDCI's proposal for community purchase of the police station and converting it into hostel accommodation

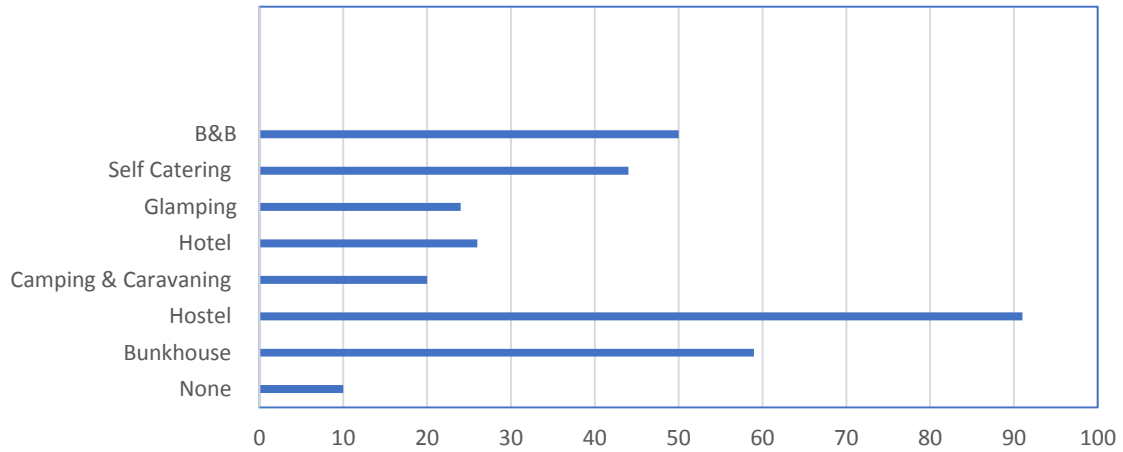


Q2. Do you believe Lairg would benefit from additional tourist accommodation?

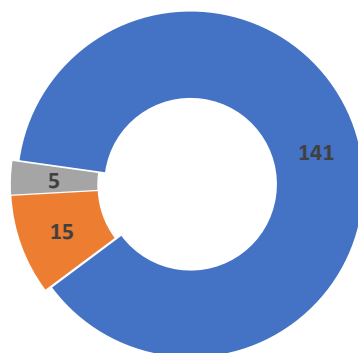

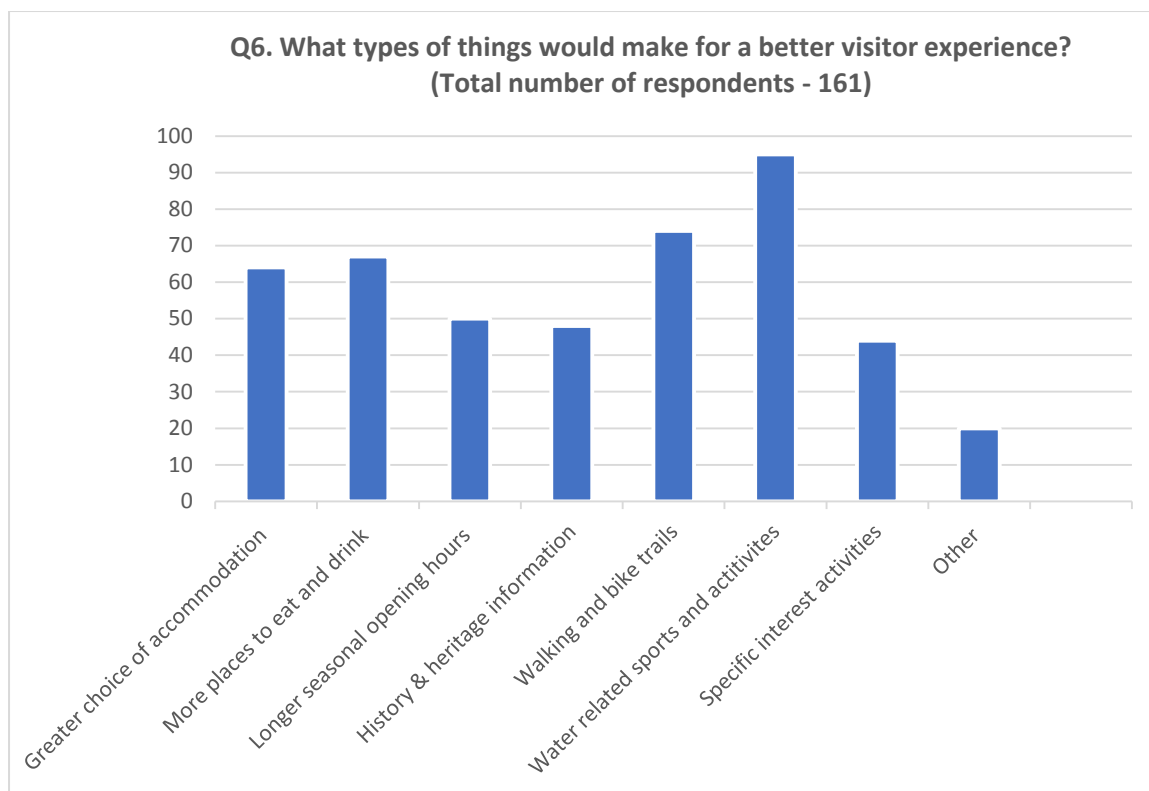
