HOW TO RECLAIM VEHICLE

You should claim the said vehicle by either attending in person or by nominating a third person to attend on your behalf at the **specified Police Station**. The person attending must produce the following before the vehicle may be released:

- Satisfactory proof of ownership of the said vehicle or proof that the person is the registered keeper.
- A valid certificate of insurance covering the use of said vehicle.
- A valid driving licence authorising that person to drive the said vehicle.

YOU are advised that charges are payable under these regulations by the registered keeper, vehicle owner or driver in respect of the seizure and retention of the said vehicle. The vehicle may be retained until the charges are paid.

If the vehicle is not claimed within 14 days of the date on this seizure notice it will be disposed of in terms of the Regulations.

On production of the required documentation at the specified Police Station this notice will be stamped by Police Scotland as proof to the Recovery Operator that you have complied with the terms of the Act as at a), b) and c) above.
