**FREEDOM OF INFORMATION (SCOTLAND) ACT 2002**

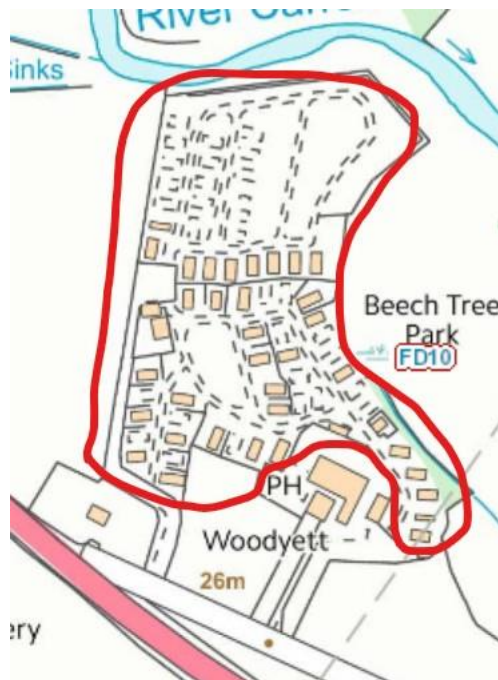
I refer to your recent request for information which has been handled in accordance with the Freedom of Information (Scotland) Act 2002.

For ease of reference, your request is replicated below together with the response.

**I write to ask for information on HOW MANY incidences have been reported to and logged by Police Scotland which occurred at Beechtree Park from May 2018 to May 2022.**

**The full address is: Beechtree Park, Falkirk Rd, Denny, FK6 6BU.**

Following a clarification request you confirmed that incidents at the Horsemill Inn Public House which borders the park should not be included. The area within the red line was used as the basis of this search.



I can confirm that 38 incidents were found in the time period requested. I would ask you to note the following caveats:

- All statistics are provisional and should be treated as management information. All data have been extracted from Police Scotland internal systems and are correct as at 8th June 2022.
- The data was extracted from the Storm Unity Database using the incident's raised date.
- The Grid East and Grid North attributed to the Storm Incident were plotted on an ArcGIS Map. Incidents located at Beechtree Park, Denny, FK6 6BU, were then selected. Please note, the Grid East and Grid North relates to where Police Officers are directed to attend.
- A keyword search was also carried out on the locus line, and relevant records were selected.

Should you require any further assistance please contact Information Management quoting the reference number given.

If you are dissatisfied with the way in which Police Scotland has dealt with your request, you are entitled, in the first instance, to request a review of our actions and decisions.

Your request must specify the matter which gives rise to your dissatisfaction and it must be submitted within 40 working days of receiving this response - either by email to [foi@scotland.pnn.police.uk](mailto:foi@scotland.pnn.police.uk) or by post to Information Management (Disclosure), Police Scotland, Clyde Gateway, 2 French Street, Dalmarnock, G40 4EH.

If you remain dissatisfied following the outcome of that review, you are thereafter entitled to apply to the Office of the Scottish Information Commissioner within six months for a decision. Should you wish to appeal against the Office of the Scottish Information Commissioner's decision, there is an appeal to the Court of Session on a point of law only.
