The data was extracted using the incident's created date and Initial Service Code. Incidents created between 1st January 2019 and 30th June 2022 were selected.

Specified areas have been selected using GIS Mapping. The Grid East and Grid North recorded on the Incident, relates to the location Police Officers have been directed to attend. Incidents within a 100 metre radius of Druid Temple Crescent and Holm Dell Avenue, Inverness, have been selected (whereby the specific house number of each location is the centre of the radius).

If you are dissatisfied with the way in which Police Scotland has dealt with your request, you are entitled, in the first instance, to request a review of our actions and decisions.

Your request must specify the matter which gives rise to your dissatisfaction and it must be submitted within 40 working days of receiving this response - either by email to foi@scotland.police.uk or by post to Information Management (Disclosure), Police Scotland, Clyde Gateway, 2 French Street, Dalmarnock, G40 4EH.

If you remain dissatisfied following the outcome of that review, you are thereafter entitled to apply to the Office of the Scottish Information Commissioner within six months for a decision. Should you wish to appeal against the Office of the Scottish Information Commissioner's decision, there is an appeal to the Court of Session on a point of law only.
